SYMPOSIUM

Revisiting Dieter Roth (1930–1998): Transnational Networks, Contemporary Perspectives, and Ongoing Research is an international symposium dedicated to Roth's interdisciplinary artistic practice spanning design, architecture, applied arts and institutional critique. The event brings together researchers, curators and practitioners across exhibition-making, archival practice, oral history, art history, technical research and conservation. The gathering aims to reassess Roth's transnational nomadic network connecting Germany, Iceland and Switzerland while establishing a dialogical space for his multifaceted methodologies. By engaging directly with his distinct conceptual vocabulary, the symposium reexamines central questions regarding authorship, genre fluidity, modes of creation, institutional demands and contemporary reception.
